Welcome to Cattle Country Farm Park, we hope you have a great day with us. On arrival please park in our Overflow Carpark where a member of staff will come and meet you

Please take note of the following safety information and share with all staff and supervisors on your visit:

- The supervision of your children is your responsibility. All under-18s must be accompanied by a responsible adult and be supervised at all times. You must assess the suitability of play equipment for each child before use, and adhere to the rules for each attraction
- Cattle Country Farm Park is an outdoor attraction, please make sure that all children wear suitable outdoor footwear and are dressed for the Great British Weather!
- Please make sure that all children bring socks, refillable water bottles and are wearing trainers or footwear suitable for outdoor play
- As many of our attractions are outside, the decision of what activities are available on the day (and timings) are decided by the Cattle Country Team. This decision is final and is to ensure safe use of equipment, adequate staffing and fair allocation of activities between all children on the visit
- When entering our Indoor Play Barns and Sand Barn shoes must be removed and stored on the racking provided



- When using our slides, always make sure the exit is clear, tuck your arms in and slide one at a time. Children are not permitted to slide on laps, unless they are using the yellow wavy slide in the Top Play Barn
- Please help us to keep the park tidy; use the Recycling & General Waste bins provided and do not throw balls or sand
- If you would like to leave bags and coats, please speak to our team on arrival
- If anyone in your group requires First Aid, please speak to a member of staff who will be able to assist. Any children who are not able to re-join the group after an accident must be collected by their parent or guardian as soon as possible. Please make sure that you have the Emergency Contact Details for each child to hand
- We usually open our Gift Shop towards the end of your visit, and have items priced from £1. Our Gift Shop takes cash and card payments
- Lost Property and Lost Children will be taken to the Gift Shop to be reunited

- Please be aware that you may not have sole use of the park during your visit and other schools may be in attendance
